Parents and Teachers were done by Bjorn B Mathews of 7B.

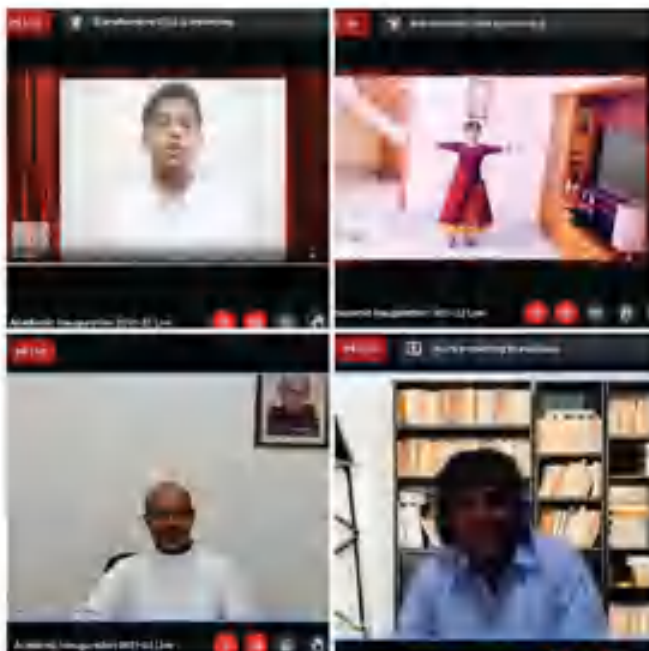

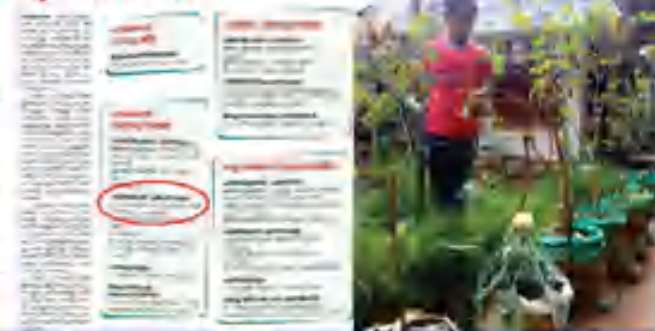

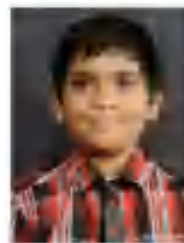

## Corona Virus (COVID-19)

Introduction- Corona virus which is commonly called as COVID-19 is an infectious disease. This is a new virus and its spread rate is very fast. COVID-19 was first identified in December 2019 in Wuhan city of China. But now, this virus has spread to almost all countries of the World Health Organization (WHO) declared the COVID-19 outbreak a pandemic.

### Symptoms

The most common symptoms of corona virus are fever, cough and short aches and pains, nasal congestion, runny nose and sore throat. Most people recover from the disease without needing special treatment.

### How does COVID-19 spread

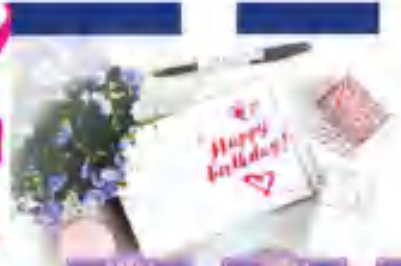

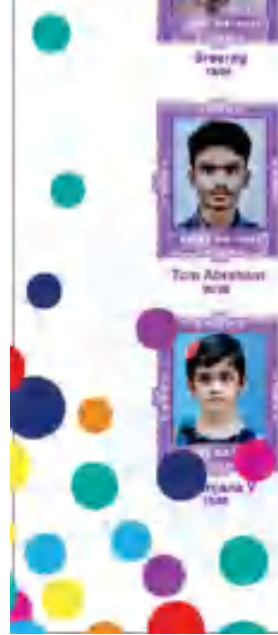

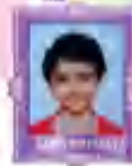
