### **STAFF ENRICHMENT PROGRAMME**

The Capacity to learn is a gift. The ability to learn is a skill, the willingness to learn is a choice. Teachers, the embodiments of knowledge constantly strive to innovate and excel in their expertise fields. As a part of the orientation, the teachers of our school had an opportunity to attend various in-service workshops.

A two-day capacity building programme to re-kindle the technology and methodology in teaching-learning process by the resource person Rev. Fr.Anson and Fr.Saji respectively. (Mr. Thomas)

The teachers of all subjects got opportunity to participate in capacity building workshops in various schools in the district to excel in their specialised fields. CBSE has initiated career guidance workshops to upgrade their professional skills. 'My kids', Special training for Kindergarten teachers to initiate a paradigm shift in the way English is taught and its innovative methodology in developing communicative skills.

Rev Fr. George Puthenchira, Director, Child-line and team handled a session highlighting on POCSO - child rights and the role of teachers in protecting children from various abuses. Teachers could also take part in a faculty advancement program- 'Summit', organized by the Dept.Education & Mass Media, Preshitha Province, Coimbatore.

### **STUDENT ENRICHMENT PROGRAMME**

To ensure our student is equipped to face any challenge, we have focused on few student enrichment programs. A career development programme was organized for classes Viii to X by Mr.Methil Krish.

The school organized an Awareness programme on Anti drugs headed by Mr. Jacob John, Deputy Excise Commissioner and an open interaction with the students on Anti Drugs by Mr.Arun Das and Mr.Satish PK , Circle Inspector of excise, Palakkad led by Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organizations.

Our students also attended an awareness programme on 'Fire and Safety' at Bhavans VidyaMandir, Chithali.

On the observance of Vigilance week, the EPF Department, Palakkad conducted an essay competition on students' vision of corruption-free India.

Students representatives attended a one day workshop on Students Rights conducted by Mathrubhumi at Mercy College .

Students got an opportunity to attend the OISCA Top Teen exams and SreeGayathri of grade X was one of the top scorers.

Raseela of grade X delivered a seminar on the topic 'PaithrukaSmrithikal' organized by OISCA, Women's Chapter, Palakkad.

SEWA (Social Empowerment through Work Education and Action) is a newly introduced stream of activity based curriculum to enhance the mental, social and emotional health of the child. As part of SEWA our school initiated different skill based training to students such as cleanliness of classrooms, surroundings, visit to nearby old age homes, interviews and interaction to public personalities. The students of higher classes were given opportunity to take flood related classes in different grades. A sense of team work and creativity among students were traced from the SUPW such as carpet making ,gift wrappings etc. Athletics and health and fitness are also given importance in the curriculum where students were technically tested in different spots and games.

A general body meeting was held to form a PTA, thereby the president and the representatives were elected.

Parent Teacher Gatherings were held on a regular basis to update the parents with the progress of their wards in both academic and non-academic fields and awareness programmes for providing effective parenting were also organized

#### **ECO CLUB**

Eco Club initiated various activities in the school campus giving importance and awareness by planting more trees and making the school campus go green. Along with this, an organic vegetable garden is also maintained.

The Swachh Bharat Abhiyan was followed in the school campus as a part of the Eco-club activities. Various programmes were organised, where students took initiative to clean the school campus. An essay competition on ozone depletion was also held in this regard. In connection with Gandhi Jayanthi 'Sevanavaram' was observed and a few students participated in the painting competition and were duly honoured by Sri MundurSethumadhavan.

VaniParvathy, Jesia and Megha of grade IX were selected as the Student Reporters 2018-19 and also attended the workshop of Mathrubhumi Seed Project. Monitoring by the teachers were also done on a regular basis to ensure the effective maintenance of the vegetable gardens.

The school also got an opportunity to associate with Mr. Deepak Varma who has a record of conducting a 24 hour cleanliness programme giving awareness to the children that cleanliness of the surrounding is a credential of healthy living.

To create an awareness on Nature conservation and to instil the life skills of social adjustment and self-reliance, the students of grade VII and VIII were taken on a two day educational camp at Silent Valley.

### **HEALTH CLUB**

Health club has been active throughout the year with their tremendous contribution to spread the awareness of health and well-being posters and charts are displayed at regular intervals depicting various current health problem due to sedentary lifestyle.

As a part of health club activities the school organized a two day eye camp led by a team of expert ophthalmic medical practitioners from Trinity Eye Hospital, Palakkad.

Students and teachers also had an opportunity to witness the honouring ceremony and interact with the Grand mother of the forest and the medical messiah, vaidyamma, Padmasree Dr.LakshmikuttyAmma. It was indeed a fruitful session where we could get information about the natural remedies for chronic diseases.
